I became the manager of the Consumer Law Office for the Legal Aid Society, in which capacity I worked on a wide variety of civil matters and supervised St. Louis University law students assigned to my office to assist clients.

For several years I was employed by a law firm in the San Francisco Bay area, engaging in a wide ranging civil and trial practice. I returned to the metropolitan St. Louis area to start a law firm with other attorney's, with whom I then practiced for over 20 years.

I am admitted to practice in the state courts of Missouri and California, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Missouri, and the United States Supreme Court.

During the course of my practice, I have been involved in, represented and counseled clients in a wide variety of matters, including but not limited to:

- 1. Business Law I have been involved in the formation, operation, merger and acquisition, and dissolution or liquidation of businesses. I have tax qualified not for profit businesses. I have been involved in a wide range of business litigation including contracts, real estate, and torts.
