In 1994, I helped to form a St. Louis chapter of the American Academy of Attorney-Mediators, after participating in its Basic Mediator training, although I did not act as a mediator at that time. Recently, I decided to add mediation to my practice and participated in a 2.5 day civil mediation training presented by the Washington University School of Law Alternative Dispute Resolution Program with assistance from U.S. Arbitration and Mediation Midwest, Inc.
