MAURICE B. GRAHAM

Maurice B. Graham concentrates his practice in the area of litigation, including, medical negligence, product liability, and corporate litigation He also practices extensively in the area of corporate law and health law.

For 32 years, Mr. Graham was a partner in a Fredericktown, Missouri law firm. At the time he moved his practice to St. Louis, he was the senior partner of Schnapp, Graham, Reid & Fulton. After moving to St. Louis, he was a partner with Padberg, McSweeney, Slater, Merz & Graham before establishing The Graham Law Firm in June of 1997.

Mr. Graham was born in Fredericktown, Missouri, July 2, 1938. He was educated at Central Methodist College and the University of Missouri-Columbia where he received his B.A. degree in 1960, and his J.D. degree in 1962. During law school he was president of the law school Board of Governors.

He is admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court, and the Fifth, Eighth and Ninth Circuits of the United States Court of Appeals, in addition to being admitted in the state and federal courts of Missouri.

Mr. Graham was a member of the Missouri Bar Board of Governors from 1980 through 1990, and was President of the Missouri Bar in 1988-89.

He is a member of the Missouri Bar Association, and the Bar Association of Metropolitan St. Louis. He is a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers and member of the International Society of Barristers. He is a fellow of the American Bar Foundation. He is licensed to practice law in Missouri and Colorado. Mr. Graham has handled cases in federal and state courts throughout Missouri, and in courts in Montana, Illinois, Texas, and Arizona.

Mr. Graham received a Special Merit Citation from the American Judicature Society in 1989, and received a Citation of Merit from the University of Missouri-Columbia Law School in 1988. In 1992, he was honored by the University of Missouri-Columbia with a Distinguished Alumni Award. He was President of the University of Missouri-Columbia Law School Foundation and a member of the University Development Committee.

Mr. Graham served for 8 years as a member of the Missouri Supreme Court Advisory Committee and was Chairman of the Committee when his term expired December 21, 1998.

He served as President of the Mineral Area College Foundation Board of Trustees and is a former President of the Presbyterian Children's Services Board of Trustees. He is a member of the Board of Curators of Central Methodist College, Fayette, Missouri. He serves as President of the Friends of the Sheldon Concert Hall in St. Louis.

Mr. Graham and his wife, Edna Mae, reside in Clayton, Missouri, and have one son, Lee, age 25.
