



We are happy to inform you that you were the successful bidder to provide mediation services for Missouri Department of Transportation.

Enclosed is a set of plans for Project J0S0620 in Dunklin Co. for your information. We anticipate a 50% condemnation rate on this project and the date it must be turned over to District Counsel for filing of condemnation is July 1, 1999. A county map is also included for location reference.
