I currently serve, and have served for over ten years, as a judge in the St. Louis University Law School appellate advocacy program, and in the past, for approximately five years, in the Washington University Law School appellate advocacy program. For the last two years I have served as a judge in the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court competition at Washington University School of Law, and have been invited to serve as a judge in the Midwest Regional Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court competition in the winter of 2000, with twelve law schools participating. I believe my experience in the law practice, in teaching, and while serving as a judge in varying capacities has provided me with the substantive professional skills to effectively mediate controversies within the judicial process and, in addition, by having an undergraduate degree in psychology (with a minor in sociology), I believe I will be sensitive to structuring and advancing an effective psychodynamic environment that I feel is essential in the mediation process. 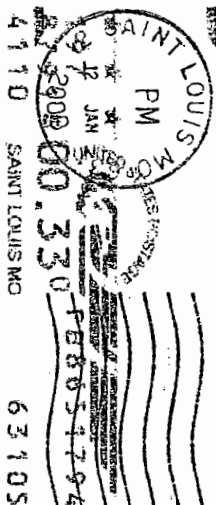
